SP LOW VOLTAGE QUAIL STUNNER

Our low voltage quail stunner has been adapted specifically for use with Quail.

The wall mounted transformer unit is fitted with volt and ammeters which connects to the stun block. The stun block delivers 130v to the two copper strips of the V when the foot pedal is pressed.

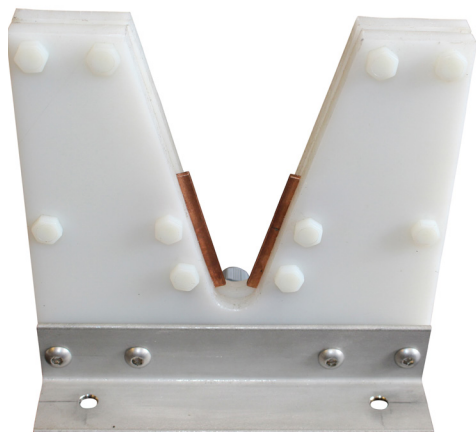

Bolt the control box to the wall.



Bolt the stunner block to a table and connect to the control box via the yellow plug.



PLEASE NOTE THAT ANYONE USING THIS STUNNER MUST HAVE UNDERGONE TRAINING AND HAVE A SLAUGHTERING LICENSE.

The stun is achieved when the foot pedal is depressed applying 130v between the copper strips on the stun block.

Ideally the stunning and killing of poultry should take place in a quiet darkened room using a dim red or blue light. Birds in this environment are quiet and relaxed which will ultimately make for much easier plucking and will have a beneficial affect on the meat.

ALWAYS TRY TO MINIMISE STRESS

Holding the bird breast up and using your thumb gently against the birds neck, carefully position the birds head between the copper strips. Take care not to pull the birds neck excessively and cause undue stress or pain. When the birds head has good contact with the copper strips, press the pedal to deliver the stun.

The amount of time required for stunning can take up to 10 seconds depending on the size of the bird. Initially the bird will spasm and go rigid, then it will relax and the stun is complete.

ALWAYS TAKE CARE TO ENSURE YOU DO NOT HAVE DIRECT CONTACT YOURSELF WITH THE COPPER STRIPS BEFORE PRESSING THE PEDAL.

The small size of quail makes them difficult to electrically stun with a hand held tool. Every effort has been made to make this system as safe as possible to use, in the interest of operator safety, only 65v are delivered through either of the terminals. However due to the small nature of quail you will inevitably be in close proximity of the terminals so extra care must be taken
